

This class will give you the option of selecting and working to a grade you desire. You may earn an A, B, C or F. There will be no D's given in the class. You will select the grade you wish and complete the appropriate assignment or assignments. For each higher grade, you must complete the lower grade assignment. If you wish for an A, you must complete all three assignments. Please understand that by completing these projects you have not earned that grade, you are now eligible for the grade. You must complete all other assigned work and obtain the appropriate number of points for that grade.

C Assignment

Student will attend an Open Meeting agreed upon by both the instructor and the student. There is a one page form that needs to be completed. The student will need to stay for at least one hour. The student will also need to get a copy of the agenda and then a copy of the minutes. The minutes are available a week or so after the meeting. Some examples of Open Meetings include but are not limited to school board meetings, city council meetings, and other governmental agencies that hold open meetings.

B Assignment

The student will complete the C assignment and the Great Man Paper. The Great Man paper is a 2-3 page research paper of a man that has influenced government. The student will be able to select a man from a list. All the requirements are noted on the assignment sheet.

A Assignment

The student will complete the C and B assignment and the Annotated Bibliography assignment. The student will select an area of study related to government agreed upon by both the student and teacher. The student will select no less than 15 sources related to the topic. The student will write a short summary on why the source was helpful or not to the topic.
